What makes editorial illustration stand out from typical narrative painting or drawing is that it is always an image, or series of images, accompanying text, such as a news article, book review, short story, poem, and more. In this workshop, students will reference one article, short story, and/or poem, curated by the instructor, to create a series of idea sketches before arriving at a final illustration.

Through guided exercises, they will explore light, shadow, and value to create the illusion of depth and form. Students will then apply these techniques to real-life still life drawings. This class builds strong foundational skills essential for realistic drawing.

Through step-by-step exercises, students will learn how light and shadow define facial features and create depth. By the end of the class, students will complete a finished portrait while strengthening their observational drawing skills.
