Throughout the year, they build a portfolio of artwork that culminates in our annual Year-End Art Show.

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Art Portfolio / University Prep is an advanced program for students preparing for art school admissions, AP/IB Art, scholarships, competitions, or building a professional portfolio. Students receive one-on-one mentorship while developing a strong body of work that emphasizes technical skill, creative thinking, research, and personal artistic voice. Each portfolio is customized to the student's goals and admission requirements, helping them confidently prepare for post-secondary applications and interviews.

iPad Illustration (Digital Art)	T or F 3:00-6:00pm	Grades 4 to 9	\$45 / 2hrs
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iPad Illustration introduces students to the fundamentals of digital art using Procreate on the iPad or tablet. Students learn digital drawing techniques, including the use of layers, brushes, color theory, and illustration workflows while creating original artwork. Following the same monthly curriculum as our Art Foundations program, students develop their skills through guided projects that work toward our annual Year-End Art Show, with lessons tailored to each student's skill level and artistic goals.

***Art Foundations and Art Portfolio / University Prep** classes follow an **Open Studio** format, allowing students to work on individual projects at their own pace with personalized guidance from an instructor. Our classes follow a monthly curriculum that builds skills and techniques throughout the year, with students creating artworks that work toward our annual Year-End Art Show. Students register for a regular weekly drop-in time during our open studio hours, providing flexibility while maintaining consistent progress.*

Class Schedule & Holiday Information

Studio Hours: The studio hours listed above are our general operating schedule. Class times may be adjusted based on student registration and enrollment needs.

Tuition Pricing: Class fees are calculated based on the number of scheduled classes after statutory holidays and studio closures have been removed. As a result, students registered on different days of the week may have different tuition amounts and number of classes per semester depending on the holiday schedule.

Studio Closures: Our studio follows the Langley School District calendar and is closed on select statutory holidays and school breaks. We are not open on all statutory holidays. If studio is closed due to inclement weather, it will be announced on our website and parents or guardians will be contacted via email at least 3hrs prior to open hours. We will do our best to provide make up classes.

Winter, Spring, Summer Breaks: Studio hours may vary during breaks.

Pro-D Days & Camps: On select Pro-D Days, we may offer full-day Art Day Camps for students. Camp availability and registration details will be announced separately.

Registration & Tuition Options

Early Bird Registration: Register for the Fall Semester by August 15 and receive a Drawing Starter Set, including a sketchbook, pencils, eraser, and an Art Village tote bag.

Semester Registration Savings: Full semester registration receives a 10% tuition savings compared to monthly registration.

Semester Registration Deadline: Registration for each semester closes 2 weeks after the semester begins.

Fees & Class Policies

Material Fee (MM*): Classes marked with MM* require a monthly material fee of \$30 (per 4-week period).

Missed Classes: All missed classes must be made up before the start of the next semester. Make-up classes may be scheduled during regular class times or used during our Winter Break and Spring Break open studio hours, subject to availability.
