How to Book a Private Event at Art Village

3. CONFIRMATION

Once everything is all set, we will need a non refundable deposit of 50%. The rest of the payment needs to be made before the party.



1. ANAGLYPH

This project explores the effect of two overlayed images with tinted film in contrasting colours, typically red and blue. When the images are viewed through either colour, the corresponding colour will be cancelled out and only the opposite colour shows up. This project is particularly fun as students can choose to create hidden and/or "3D" images.

2. DREAM GLOBES



With this more crafty project, students can explore the tactility of various media, such as paper, markers/ink, glitter, and glue to create an imaginative world. Everyone leaves with a one-of-a-kind dream globe!

We offer a variety of templates that best suit the season and themes of the party. From fishbowls to the traditional snowglobe, we ensure a fun artmarking experience for all!






3. MIXED MEDIA PORTRAITS
